Schools Menu

T-Lights

- After-school provision linked to Travelling Light's current productions
- Teaching drama and performance skills, led by professional theatre makers
- Includes a Theatre Director and Assistant*
- 10 weeks, with an end of term sharing
- Maximum 25 participants

Cost: £950

Details: 10 week course, 1 hour session each week

Breakdown: From £3.80 a session, £38 a term per young person

Suitable For: **Key Stage 1 & 2**

* Prices can be negotiated if an Assistant is not required



Play In A Week

- Working with a team of professionals to produce and direct a high quality performance, based around topics or themes to suit the school
- 1 x initial workshop and 1 full week off timetable
- Additional teacher team meetings in PPA time or after school
- Based on a maximum of 150 pupils

Cost: From £3600-£6900

Premier Package available for £7400

Details: Prices are negotiable and can be tailored to the schools needs

Breakdown: Around £24-£46 per young person

Suitable For: **Key Stage 1 - 4 and 16+**



Transitions

- Working with one secondary school and other feeder primaries (max 4)
- Year 6 and Year 7 pupils working together
- Creating a new piece of theatre with professionals, based on young people's ideas
- 6 x workshops in Term 6, 1 week summer school rehearsal, followed by a tour to schools in Term 1

Cost: Full package £7300

Details: Prices are negotiable and can be tailored to the schools needs

Suitable For: **Key Stage 2 and 3**



Activities Week

- Bespoke workshops, tailored to fit with school activities week
- Maximum 30 students per session
- Arts Award can be added at an additional cost

Cost: Option 1 £250 (1 half day)

Option 2 £300 (1 full day)

Option 3 £500 (5 days of 90 minute sessions)

Breakdown: Around £10-£20 per child depending on the options

Breakdown: 3 weeks of the year - February/June/July

Suitable For: **Key Stage 4**



Theatre Making

- After-school provision. Devising and theatre making for young people
- Includes a Theatre Director and Assistant*
- 10 week course
- Maximum 25 participants
- Arts Award can be added to this project at an additional cost

Cost: £1050

Details: 10 week course, 1 hour session each week

Breakdown: From £4.20 a session, £42 a term per young person

Suitable For: **Key Stage 3 & 4**
